

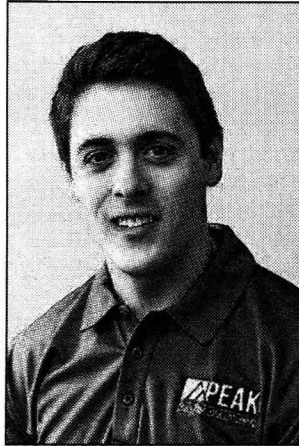
## Peak Physical Therapy names new physical therapist
